The State Government has listed the villages of Catherine Hill Bay and Middle Camp on the State Heritage Register

The listing is only the second time- following the listing of Braidwood in southern NSW four years ago- that an entire town has been placed on the State Heritage Register.

Planning Minister Tony Kelly said "These villages have been recognised for their outstanding historic and aesthetic qualities as well as the important cultural association they provide to the State's early mining and maritime industries".

However, all the work that has been done over the last 10 years in preparation for this listing by the Department of Planning; the Lake Macquarie City Council and the National Trust has recommended a much larger area be listed.
