EXCELLENT TRAFFIC NEWS!

The recommendation below was passed at the first LMCC Meeting following the Council Election.

- A. Approve the installation of humps at the following locations in Catherine Hill Bay as per attached plans:
 - Stage 1 Device 1 on Flowers Drive north of Colliery Road; Device 2
 is adjacent to H/No 1 Flowers Drive and Device 3 fronting H/No's 8/11
 Flowers Drive;
 - Stage 2 Device 4 fronting H/No's 18/21 Flowers Drive and Device 5 fronting H/No 30 Flowers Drive;
 - Stage 3 Device 12 fronting H/No's 7/8 Clarke Street and Device 14 adjacent to H/No 27 Clarke Street;
 - Stage 4 Device 6 between H/No's 36 and 42 Flowers Drive; Device 7 fronting H/No 50 Flowers Drive and Device 8 adjacent to H/No 58 Flowers Drive;
 - Stage 5 Device 9 at the bridge on Flowers Drive and Device 11 adjacent to H/No 1 Lindsley Street.
- B. Undertake further consultation in regards to altered and additional humps on Flowers Drive, Lindsley Street, Clarke Street and Northwood Road, Catherine Hill Bay.


